

94% of seniors are satisfied with their Medicare Advantage.




61% of seniors are very satisfied with their Medicare Advantage.



92% of seniors with Medicare Advantage report they are satisfiedwith their prescription drug coverage.



93% of seniors with Medicare Advantage report they are satisfied with their preventive services, like screenings, vaccines, and testing.



Over 95% of seniors with Medicare Advantage would recommend it to their family and friends.

Seniors covered by Medicare Advantage are satisfied with their plan, prescription drug coverage, and preventive services. For seniors, the most important aspects of Medicare coverage – either traditional or Medicare Advantage – are:




